

HEALTH & HUMAN DEVELOPMENT U4 - AOS2 Advice for Teachers



This activity sequence covers the following key knowledge and skills in U4 - AOS2.

Key knowledge

• the role of non-government organisations in promoting health and wellbeing, and human development

Key skills

- explain and evaluate the role of non-government organisations in promoting health and wellbeing, and human development globally
- analyse and evaluate the effectiveness of aid programs in promoting health and wellbeing, and human development

It also integrates some other key knowledge and skill points to help with students' application of knowledge and flexibility in exam conditions. The aim of this is to encourage students to think outside of the key knowledge 'box' and learn how flexible an aid project/program can be in the way it can be used in an exam.

For example, the Better Food, Better Health (BFBH) project has been selected for this activity because it could be used as an example to explain:


- aid provided by a NGO
- the impact of Australian government aid
- how the Australian government (DFAT) work in partnership with an NGO
- how the priorities of Australia's aid initiatives are carried out
