

## A Day in the Life: 5 children from around the world

This resource includes information and images about a day in the life of five children from around the world.

Use the photos in the resource *A Day in the Life - Images*, and the personal recounts from *A Day in the Life - Stories*, to introduce students to the similarities and differences of life in other places. The photos have the themes of school, play, home, chores, and family, with supplementary information in the stories.

Use a world map and identify each of the countries mentioned as students explore the lives of the five children. Ask students to make notes and complete the table in the *Student Handout* for one of the children they learn about. Sample of the table:

### Extension Activity
