 - a. What did the images suggest to you about what life in Bangladesh is like? Consider any social, environmental and/or economic factors you observed that may impact people's lives.
 - b. Was there anything in the photos that surprised you? Anything that you did not expect to see?
 - c. What other aspects of life in Bangladesh do you think there might be, that are not represented in these images?
 - d. If you were to create a set of photos to represent life in a typical Australian community, what images would you use? How are these similar or different to the images of Bangladesh?
 - e. After seeing the photos, what questions do you have about what life in Bangladesh is like?

What does the photo suggest about Bangladesh's economy, environment or society?	What questions do you have about the place in the photo or the people who live there?














