# What Have I Learned in IMPACT?

As an IMPACT member I have had the chance to contribute to the development of my community as well as my own personal development. Through ongoing, consistent participation in club meetings and projects, I have had the amazing opportunity to develop the following competencies:

**Project Management** This competency indicates that I have the skills, knowledge, and values necessary to identify and address specific community needs through community service-learning projects and social entrepreneurship.

**Communication** This competency indicates that I have the skills, knowledge, and attitude necessary to effectively communicate at the individual and group level and to adapt to situations that require different communication skills.

**Technical** This competency indicates that I have the skills, knowledge, and attitude necessary to appropriately utilize various methods and instruments in communicating and implementing community service-learning projects.

**Personal & Group Management** This competency indicates that I have the skills, knowledge, and attitude necessary for effective self-evaluation, development and implementation of a personal learning plan, and working as a team member towards a common goal.

**Innovation & Creativity** This competency indicates that I have the skills, knowledge, and attitude necessary to identify creative and innovative ideas to address problems with appropriate new solutions.

For each of these 5 competency areas, I can reach 3 levels:

- 1. The BLUE level: basic achievement
- 2. The ORANGE level: medium achievement
- 3. The GREEN level: advanced achievement

#### **Rules for Self-Evaluation**

On the next few pages, you will have the chance to see what specific knowledge, values, and skills you've developed in IMPACT based on a standardized list of indicators. Read through the lists and check off all of the indicators that are true for you. Based on the number of checks made on each list, you will be able to assess your current level of achievement in each competency area. Be honest with yourself! After you have checked the indicators you believe you've achieved, ask your IMPACT leader to confirm. If they agree, they will give you a sticker (or multiple) in your IMPACT Passport to show what level of achievement you've reached!

# Project Management

I have learned from community members about problems they face and their real needs.

I have offered information to another person about the community in which I live (geography, economic conditions, demographic description, needs and desires of residents, etc.) at least one time.

I have discussed and supported my point of view regarding a community problem while my club was choosing an IMPACT project.

I have assumed clear responsibilities in the development of a community service-learning project with my IMPACT club.

I have shared examples with my club of ways to find solutions and resolve community needs, which I learned from people outside of IMPACT.

I have actively contributed to the project planning process with my IMPACT club – including planning activities, time limits an tasks, and setting clear objectives.

I have estimated the resources (human, material, time, and others) needed for the activities of at least one project.

I have used specific project-planning tools (e.g. Gantt Diagrams, budget templates, Excel spreadsheets, etc.).

I have helped write a budget for a community service-learning project.

I have personally approached community sponsors and/or donors to support a service-learning project with finances or in-kind donations.

I have participated in monitoring activities for a service-learning project and helped adapt a plan based on changes during the implementation period.

I have taken part in at least one evaluation & reflection meeting where I analyzed the success and impact of a completed service-learning project.

When I have checked **4** or more items above, I will receive the BLUE Project Management sticker in my Passport. When I have checked **8** or more items above, I will receive the ORANGE Project Management sticker in my Passport. When I have checked all **12** items above, I will receive the GREEN Project Management sticker in my Passport.

# Personal & Troup Management

I have taken part in at least one evaluation & reflection meeting in which I have reflected on my personal development through IMPACT.

I have identified my personal learning needs and written a personal learning plan in order to meet those needs.

I have set a concrete goal for what new knowledge, skills, and values I want to develop and am taking steps to develop those competencies.

I have set a deadline and chosen a person to help hold me accountable to my personal learning plan.

I can explain the role of the IMPACT Journal and Passport in my personal learning and development.

I have evaluated my personal competency development at least twice, using the IMPACT Journal and Passport.

I have led a game or other fun activity during a meeting of my IMPACT club.

I can share an example of a mistake or problem that our IMPACT club has faced and explain what I learned from that experience.

I have signed and accepted my IMPACT club's full value contract, and I work hard to respect it during all of our meetings.

I have helped my club leaders prepare for and facilitate a club meeting.

I have supported other members of my IMPACT club with personal problems both within and outside of our club meeting times.

I am consistently on time to IMPACT meetings and tell other members or leaders when I won't be able to attend.

I have expressed my ideas and opinions openly during IMPACT meetings.

I have consistently demonstrated respect for the ideas and opinions of others through my words and my actions.

I have explained to someone outside of the IMPACT club what IMPACT is and why it is important to me.

I have discussed my IMPACT club and a service-learning project to at least one local organization or institution in order to receive their support for a project.

I can explain the principle of constructive feedback and have demonstrated giving and receiving constructive feedback to at least 3 other club members.

I have helped to resolve a conflict or misunderstanding between club members.

I have interviewed a public official from my community.

I have participated in a discussion or debate during a club meeting where I presented a reasonable argument to support my opinion.

I have posted on my club's Facebook page at least three times, sharing photos, comments, or other useful information.

I have written a testimonial or success story after a service-learning project.

I have helped create promotional materials for our club and/or one of our service-learning projects.

I have added my voice to advocacy efforts with our IMPACT club through creating a petition or letter, writing an editorial, or speaking directly to a public official.

When I have checked  ${\bf 4}$  or more items above, I will receive the BLUE Communication sticker in my Passport.

When I have checked 8 or more items above, I will receive the ORANGE Communication sticker in my Passport.

When I have checked all 12 items above, I will receive the GREEN Communication sticker in my Passport.

# Innovation and Creativity

Check here!

I have helped design and create visual promotional materials for our club, such as posters, brochures, or flyers.

I have helped organize at least 2 social/teambuilding events for our club outside of regular IMPACT meetings.

I have found and successfully convinced at least one partner, donor, or sponsor to support at least one of our club's service-learning project.

I have been involved in at least 2 IMPACT projects with different themes, such as diversity, the environment, social inclusion, violence, etc.

I have helped make handmade craft items to sell as a method of fundraising for a service-learning project.

I have taken part in an IMPACT club meeting in which we used creative non-formal methods (theater forum, photovoice, street theater, flash mobs, living library, etc.).

I have predicted risks for service-learning projects and designed backup plans based on those risks.

I help our club to remain optimistic and find solutions when we encounter problems or barriers.

I show respect for other people's ideas at IMPACT meetings, even when they are different from my own.

I think "outside the box" and have proposed new ideas for service-learning projects that have challenged our club to explore new topics or issues.

I have helped design a product or service to sell for a social entrepreneurship project.

I can share examples of ways our club has creatively recycled, re-used, or substituted resources when our first choice of resource was not available.

I can list and explain the competencies and values of IMPACT and describe why they are important in my life.
