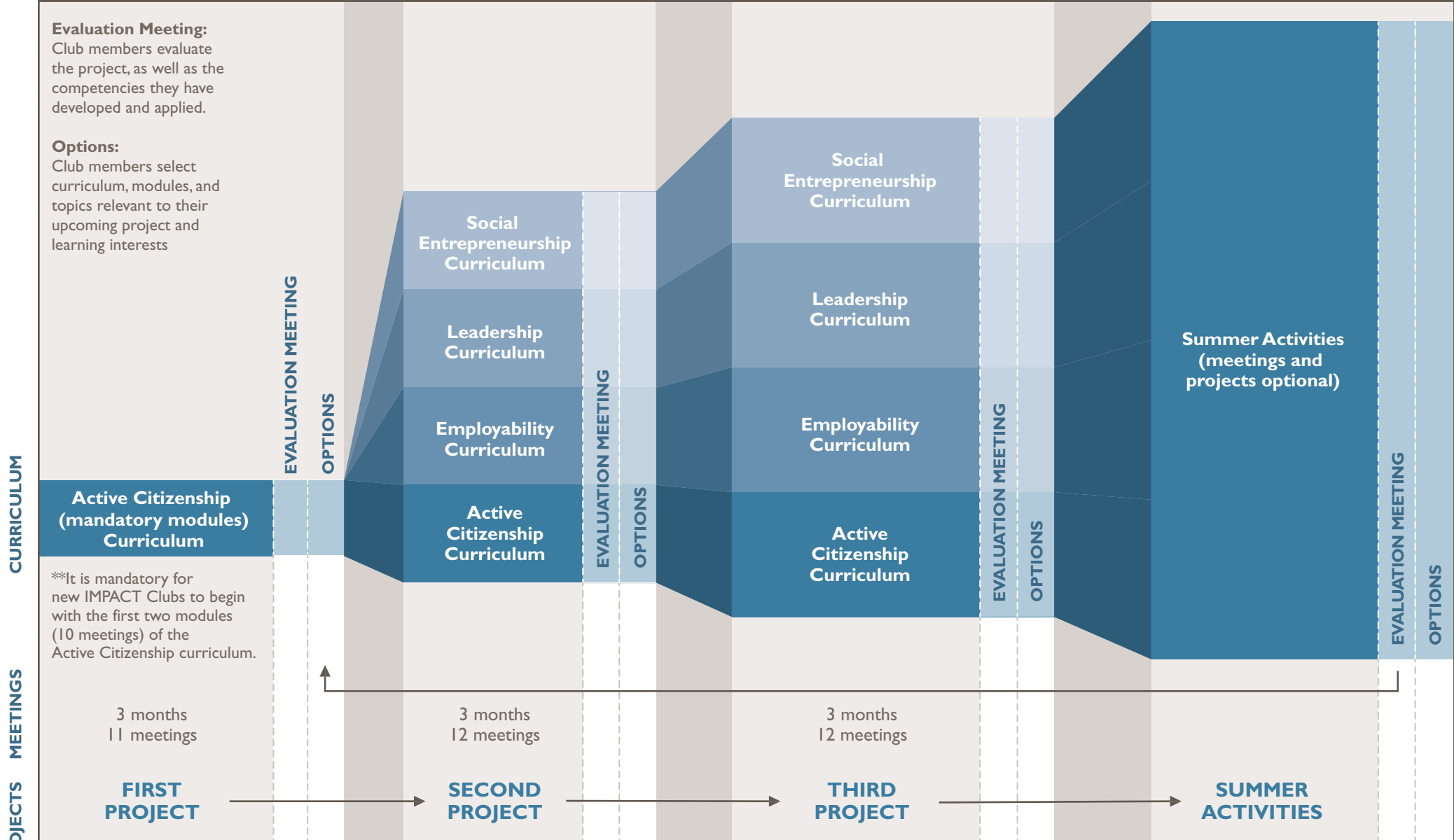


Logical structure of IMPACT Club meetings and community service-learning projects per year of activity

The IMPACT Club program is a facilitated group learning experience. The curriculum addresses topics in four main learning areas: active citizenship, employability, leadership, and social entrepreneurship. The IMPACT Club curriculum is designed to guide clubs through approximately 36 months (3 years) of weekly meetings. There is a total of 125 meetings across IMPACT's four learning pillars. Over course of one school year, 28-35 IMPACT Club meetings can be held.



At meetings, IMPACT Clubs work together to identify community problems and market opportunities, and plan and implement community service-learning and social entrepreneurship-learning projects in response – each project is increasingly complex, delves deeper into community issues. These projects allow young people to apply skills learnt in meetings to consolidate new behaviours and life skills.
