
Logical structure of SKYE Club meetings and community service-learning projects per year of activity

The SKYE Club program is a facilitated group learning experience. The curriculum addresses topics in four main learning areas: active citizenship, employability, leadership, and social entrepreneurship. The SKYE Club curriculum is designed to guide clubs through approximately 18 months (1.5 years) of weekly meetings. There is a total of 72 meetings across SKYE's four learning pillars.
